

Saudi Arabia achieves self-sufficiency in egg production

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Saudi Arabia's poultry sector has achieved complete self-sufficiency in table egg production, with output expected to exceed 8 billion eggs by 2024, according to the Ministry of Environment, Water, and Agriculture.
