

Local favorite opens new outlet in Singapore

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With the new 100-seat outlet at The Frontier Community Club in Jurong West, the chain now has a total of five branches in Singapore.

It is also Arnold's Fried Chicken's second new outlet in less than a year. Last May, the chain opened its fourth branch in Bedok.

"For the past 32 years, we've only been in the east and north of Singapore. We've had a lot of requests from Westies to open an outlet in the west, so now we've granted their request," Mr Michael Yeo, one of the directors of Arnold's Fried Chicken, told The Straits Times.
